# Stable M11 performance during fall allow them to maintain in driver seat

---

## **M11 holds first place with two games to go**

- M11 in top of table with 31 points, 3 points ahead of runner up
- But still four teams within 5 points and with possibility to claim first position at season end

## **More wins for M11 have placed them in driver seat**

- Sthlm Finest taking points in more games than M11 – but draws more often
- M11 with nine wins out of eleven games and one draw

## **M11 closing gap in goal difference thanks to offensive play**

- M11 goal scoring up from league average in spring to double of league average in fall
- However, defense with worse performance – conceded goals per game up with 33% in fall

## **Mixed messages if more offensive defenders is reason behind increase in conceded goals per game**

- Defenders share of goal scoring down from 25% in spring to 19% in fall
- But goals scored by defenders is up from 0.43 per game to 0.6

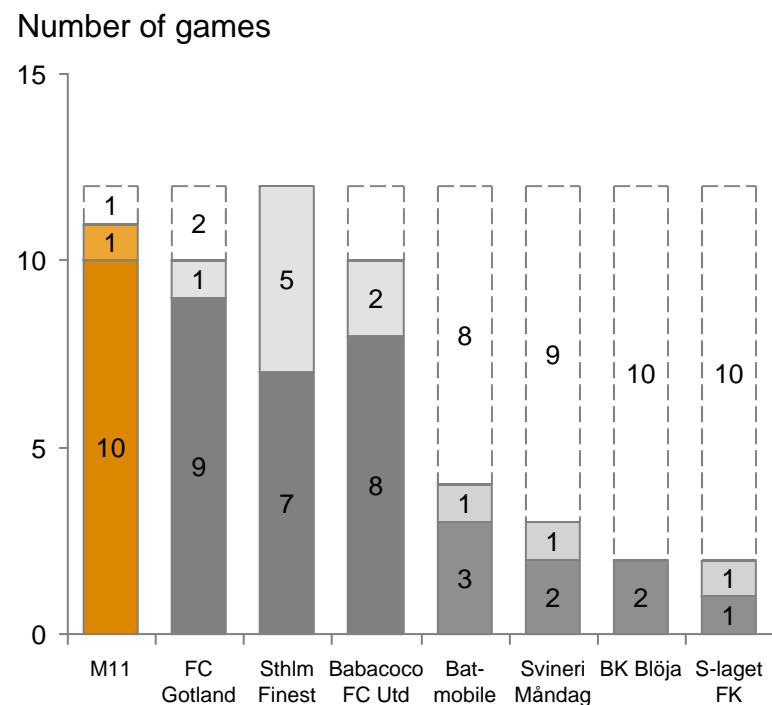
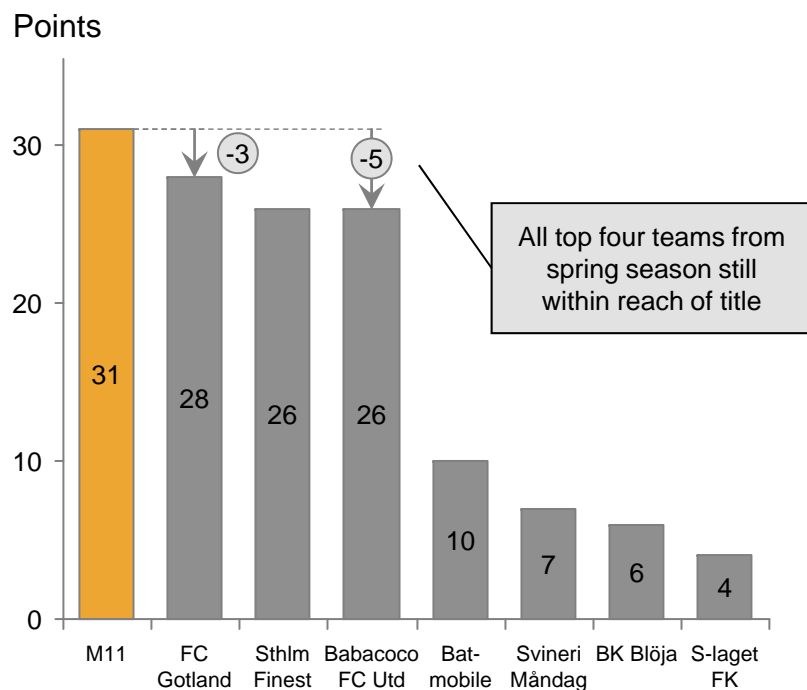


# M11 maintains first place with only two games left

Stockholm Finest only on third place despite taking points in all games

**M11 in top of table with 31 points, 3 points ahead of runner up**

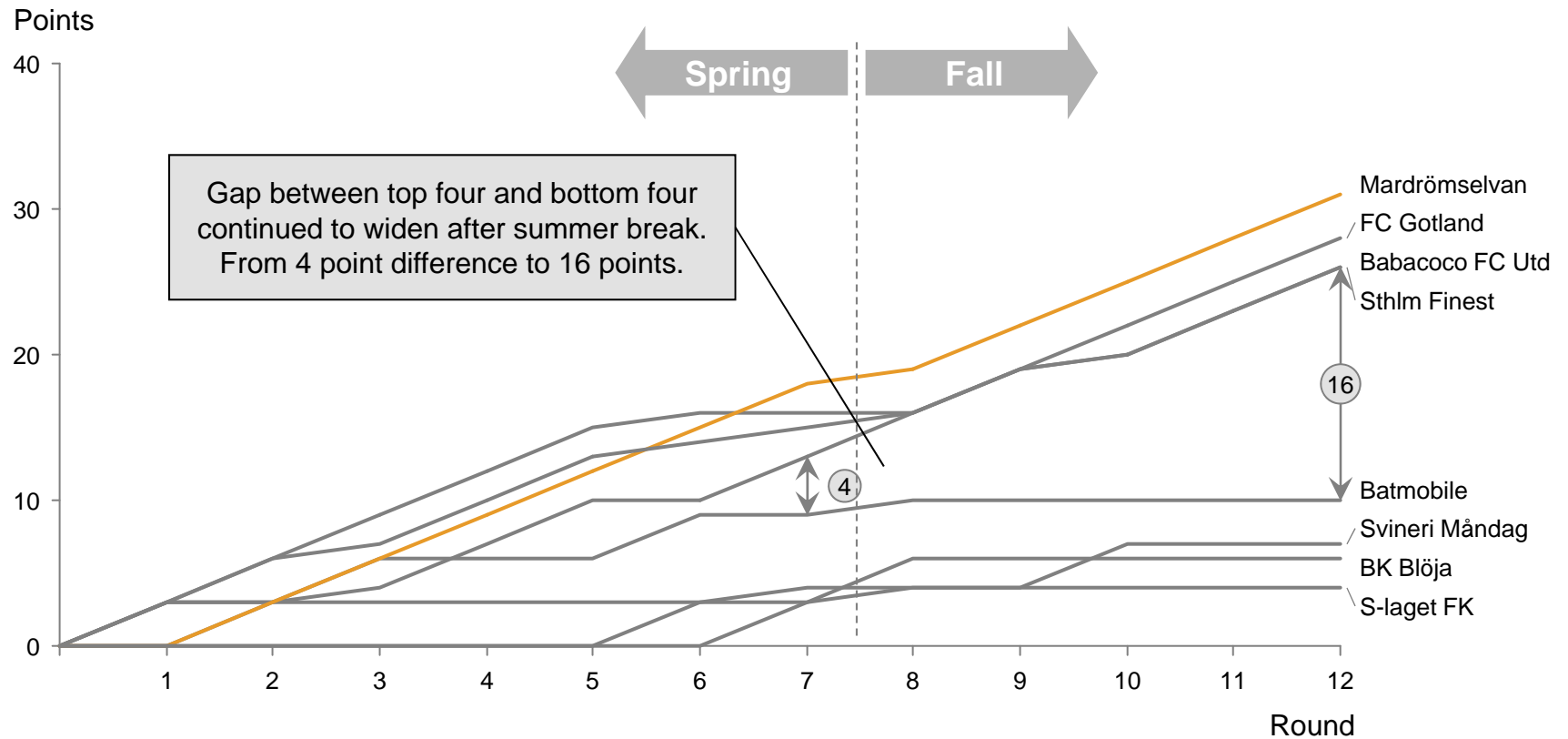

Batmobile with poor trend during fall season – only one point in first game

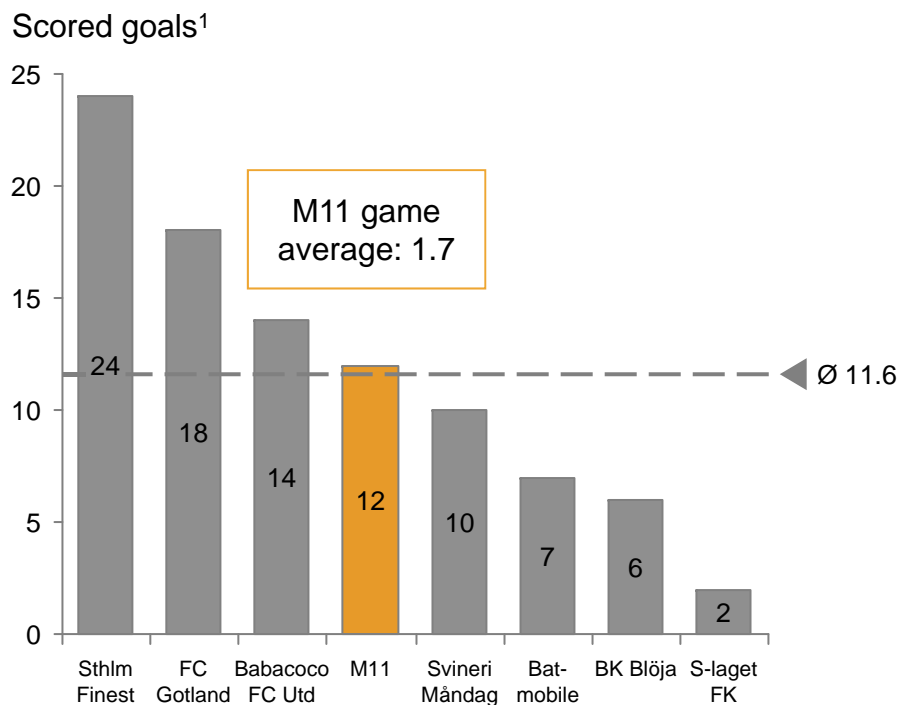




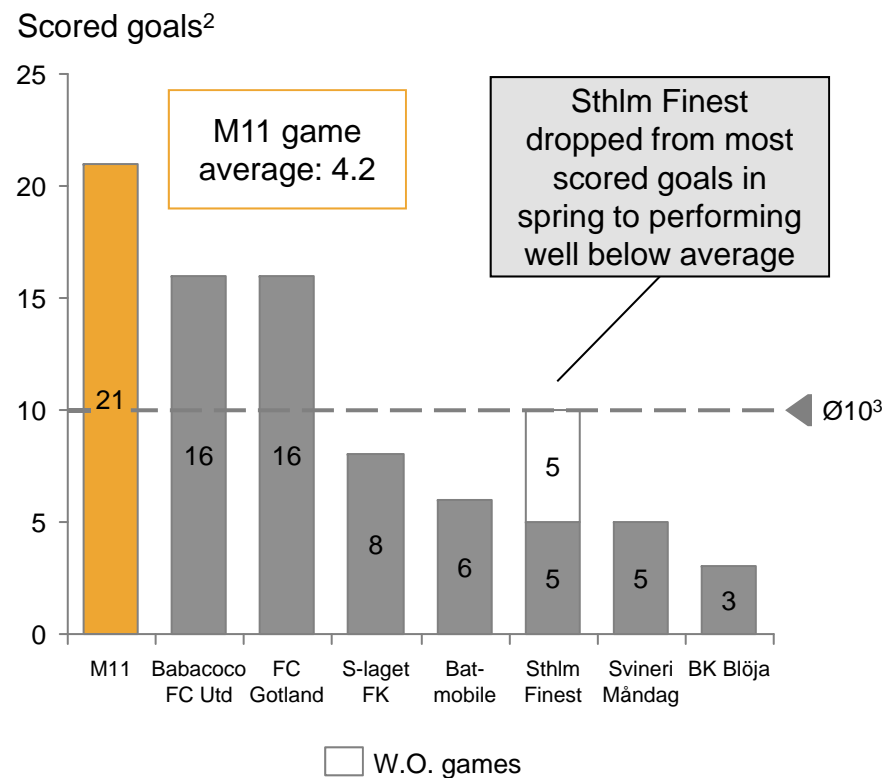
# Significant improvement in goal scoring for M11 during fall

From scoring 12 goals in seven games in spring to 21 goals in only five games

### Fall: ...has climbed to double league average

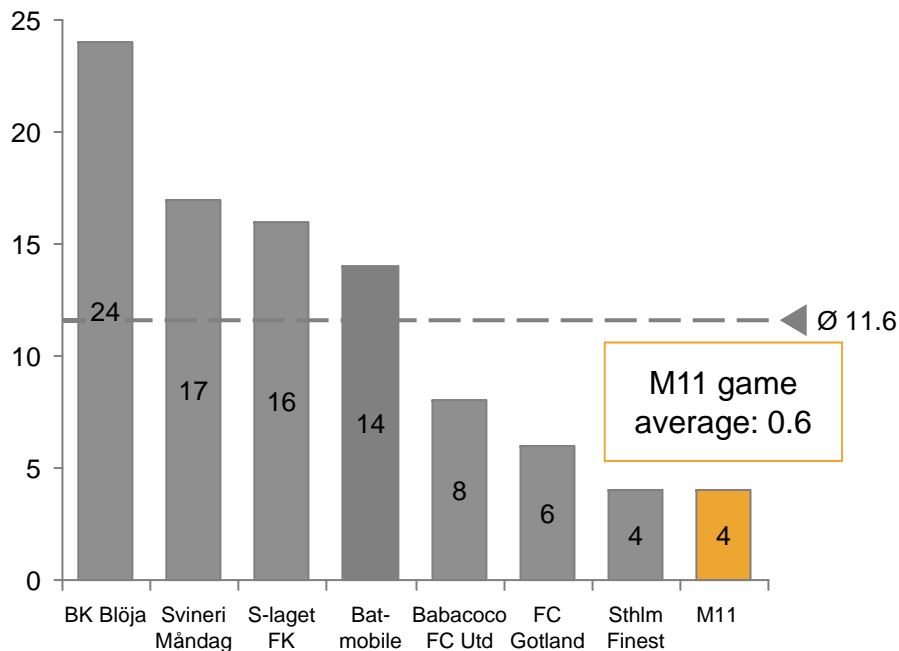

# M11 still among top three teams defensively although a 33% increase in conceded goals per game

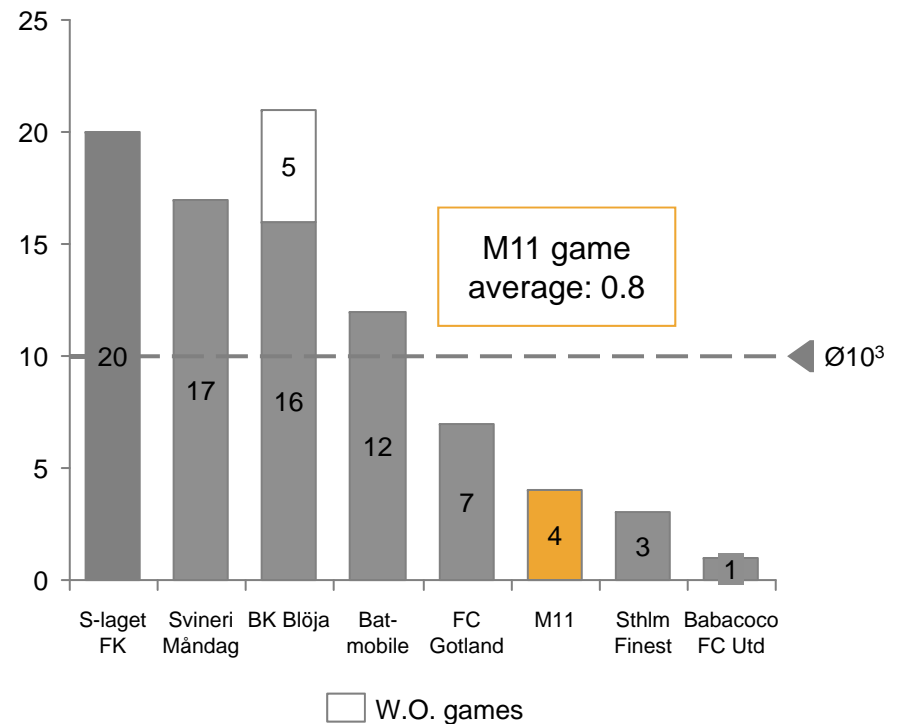
**Spring:**

Scored goals<sup>2</sup>



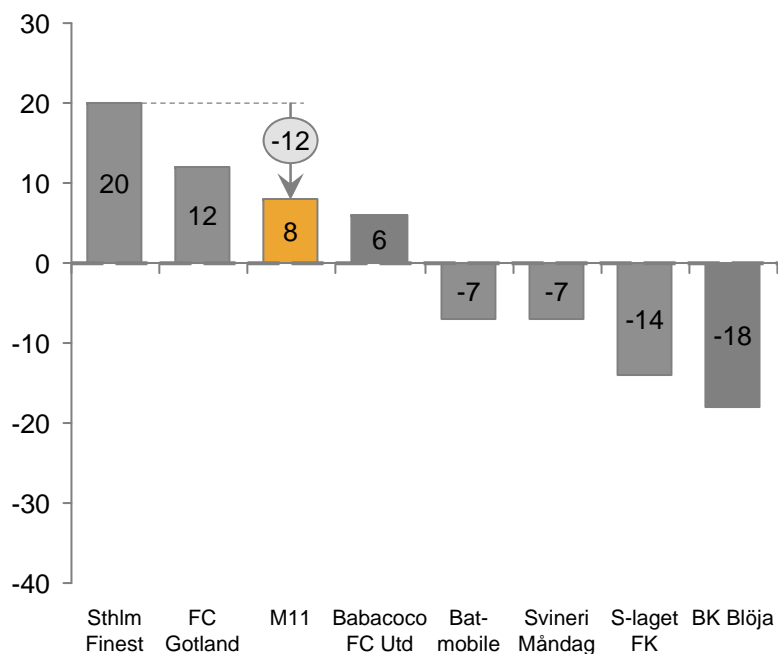

# Aggressive goal scoring offsets negative defensive trend

M11 still third in goal difference but closing in on Sthlm Finest

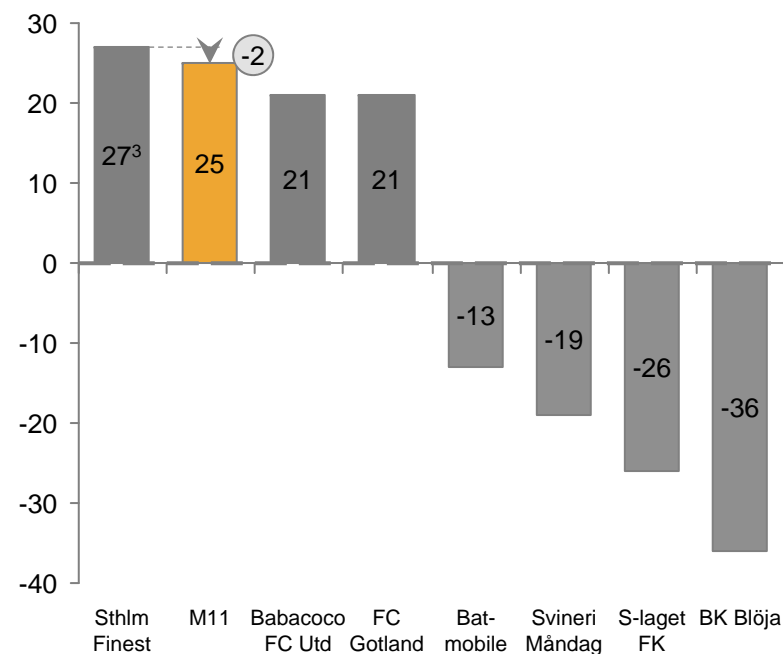
**After 7 games: M11 third in goal difference, 12 goals behind Sthlm Finest**

Cumulative goal difference<sup>2</sup>

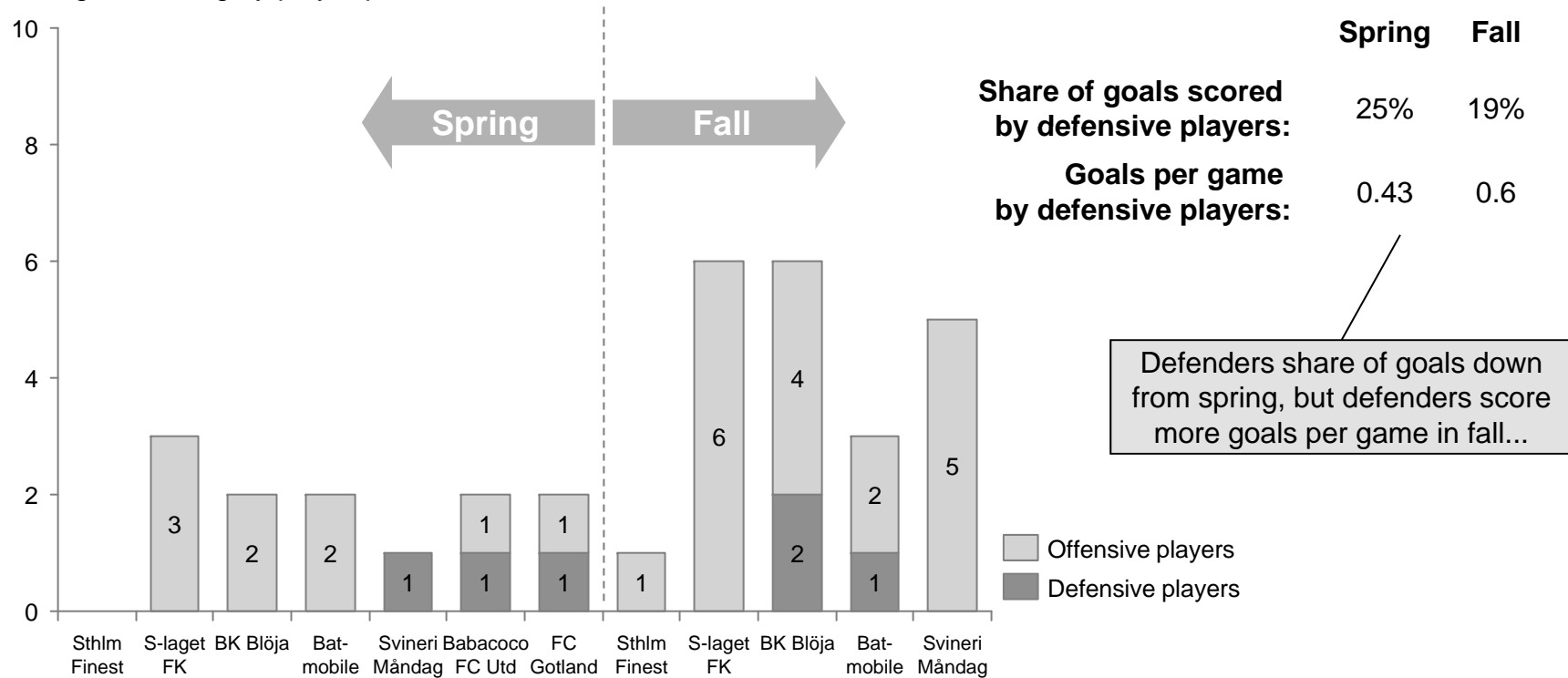

# Is more offensive defenders a myth?

Analysis give mixed messages – more goals per game but lower total share of goals for defenders
